
2024-2025 PARENT ANNUAL GIVING CHALLENGE

Parents, please label (at the very least, with first name and last initial) loose items brought to school. Hill staff try very hard to reunite known items with their keepers – give them something to go by.








Re-Enrollment for Financial Aid Families


November 25: The FAST (Financial Aid for School Tuition) process is open. Click here to begin.
