Despite the cold weather we have had a wonderful week. Kindergarten has been busy learning about dinosaurs! Through the course of the spring we will take a journey through the Triassic, Jurassic and Cretaceous periods, stopping in each period to learn about a few dinosaurs that roamed the earth during that time. This week we started with the Triassic period- when the very first dinosaurs and oldest were alive. We have met two dinosaurs on our adventure so far. Ask your little paleontologists their names and some dino facts.



This week in Math Workshop we have been playing a lot of games. The games have included "+1 or -1", "Roll and Record Two" and "Racing Bears." These games have helped us to practice adding and subtracting, writing our numbers, and comparing numbers. Ask your mathematician which game they enjoyed the most!

All the alphabet people have been very excited to meet the kindergarteners throughout the year. At this point, they cannot contain themselves anymore. Also we have been reading together and your little reader went shopping in our classroom library for new books for their reading bags. And finally we began our Spanish unit.
